



Seafield

Design and Build project by Simon Dorrell of Trance Limited. This is a one-off spacious modern build, near Knott end-on-sea, Lancashire. It is a large single storey dwelling on the coast, build using polystyrene/concrete and offering fantastic views of Morecambe bay from "The Turret".

The specification for the KNX installation for lighting control includes scene lighting throughout, a central "off" function, entrance scene lighting, internal automatic lighting at night. The "Welcome Home" lighting is triggered from a garage door remote.

The Cinema Room features lighting scenes including "black out" and IR remote provided by a Merten Plantec 8-key switch for controlling the dimming of lights. These illuminate full wall size artwork and control lamps plugged into 3 pin 5 amp wall sockets. Other features include electric vertical blinds and surround sound with everything tied together with Logitech remote control.

In the living space, Jung FD 4 gang Stainless steel switches are used for programmable scene lighting. Jung Stainless steel neutral position switches have reduced the cost of the project. Jung Presence detectors, Siemens and Jung 8 channel and 16 channel switching actuators, Siemens dimming actuators, downlights, wall up-lights, art-lights and 5 amp sockets are also included.
